A brief history of Rockford Bell Credit Union

May 13, 1935 – was the first day of Rockford Bell Credit Union.

Rockford Bell Credit Union (RBCU) was founded by employees of the Rockford Bell Telephone Company. The purpose was a convenient and safe place for Bell telephone employees and their families to save and borrow.

In 1935 RBCU wasn't alone in starting a credit union. Across the county Bell Telephone employees were organizing their own credit union's. Other Bell Credit Unions – Bell General Office. Bell West Community and Peoria Bell (just to name a few). Today Bell CU's go by their original name, have changed their name or merged into other credit unions over the years.
